**In order to complete the module, please follow these steps:**

Step 1: Register for an account (this must be using an NHS email address) at: <https://www.gptrainingeastsussex.co.uk/register/>

Step 2: Access the e-learning module either through the above website's menu, or <https://www.gptrainingeastsussex.co.uk/courses/introduction-to-learning/>

Step 3: Click 'enrol' on the right of the page. The course is then accessed under the 'curriculum' section of the page. You must complete each part of the course to unlock the next section.

Step 4: Once completed (which should take up to 4 hours), a certificate will be available via your email and the website for you to upload to your portfolio to evidence that you have completed the module.
