




Darent Valley Hospital

- One of the largest hospital Trusts in North Kent
- The hospital provides specialty services, with expanding new adventures, such as recently becoming a regional HASU and Thrombolysis Centre. We have a new state of the art MRI Scanner, which is the most advanced in Kent and have purchased surgical robotics, which is evolutionary in delivering minimally invasive surgery.

Accommodation

- Staff accommodation for students and staff is situated in the hospital grounds adjacent to the main hospital
