

### Location



- Maidstone and Tunbridge Wells
- A 25 minute drive between each hospital site OR a 30 minute free staff shuttle bus.
- Located approximately a 1 hour train journey from London.




### **Car Parking**



A monthly permit costs £24 or you can 'pay as you go' for £2 a day.

There is also a park and ride service available for each hospital which is free to use and takes 10 minutes or less to get on site.

#### Accommodation



#### Maidstone Accommodation



The Springwood Road accommodation is a 10 minute walk from Maidstone Hospital. The accommodation comprises flats of 5,6 or 7 all en-suite with their own shared kitchen, eating and lounge area.

Each room is equipped with a bed, desk, chest of drawers, bedside cabinet and wardrobe.

The lounge areas have a dining table and chairs, sofa and flat screen tv.

Facilities include: Wifi, Card access to building, flats and rooms, laundry room, domestic services for all communal areas, linen (towels and sheets – no duvets), car parking and lockable bike storage.

The new accommodation and educational facilities on the Tunbridge Wells Hospital site comprises of 145 rooms, a leisure room and educational facilities.

The accommodation comprises of flats of 4 or 6 rooms all en-suite with their own shared kitchen, eating and lounge area.

Each room will be equipped with a bed, desk, chest of drawers, bedside cabinet and wardrobe.

The lounge areas have a dining table and chairs, sofa and flat screen tv.

Facilities include: Wifi, Card access to building, flats and rooms, laundry room, domestic services for all communal areas, linen (towels and sheets – no duvets), car parking and lockable bike storage.

#### **Facilities**





Our Education Centres both have onsite state of the art Simulation facilities that include: Sim man 3G, Sim man 3G+, 2 Paediatric Sims, 2 'Nursing Ann's', 2 Babies, '2 Premature Ann's' and a 'Sim Mum'.

Simulation Clinical Skills rooms are also available for use in training.

On the Maidstone site we also have a Laparoscopic training centre located within our Academic Centre. This is fully equipped and available for training sessions, or bookable should you wish to practice your Laparoscopic surgical skills.





24 hour access Libraries are available on both sites for all staff, providing access to traditional and internet-based resources.

Modern I.T facilities and Wi-Fi access is available throughout the hospitals.

### **Social Activities/ Doctors Mess**



We have an active Doctors' Mess Committee that arrange various social events throughout the year including 'pay day' themed outings and other regular mess nights organised by F1s.

Foundation Doctors organise the Winter and Summer Ball. We also hold an annual cricket match Residents against Consultants.

#### **Maidstone**

Maidstone has its own shopping complex, many restaurants, bars, gyms, leisure centres, a cinema and theatre all within easy access from the hospital.

Leeds castle, Mote Park, the Hop Farm and Bluewater Shopping Centre are local attractions open all year round that are easily accessible using local transport links.

#### Tunbridge Wells
