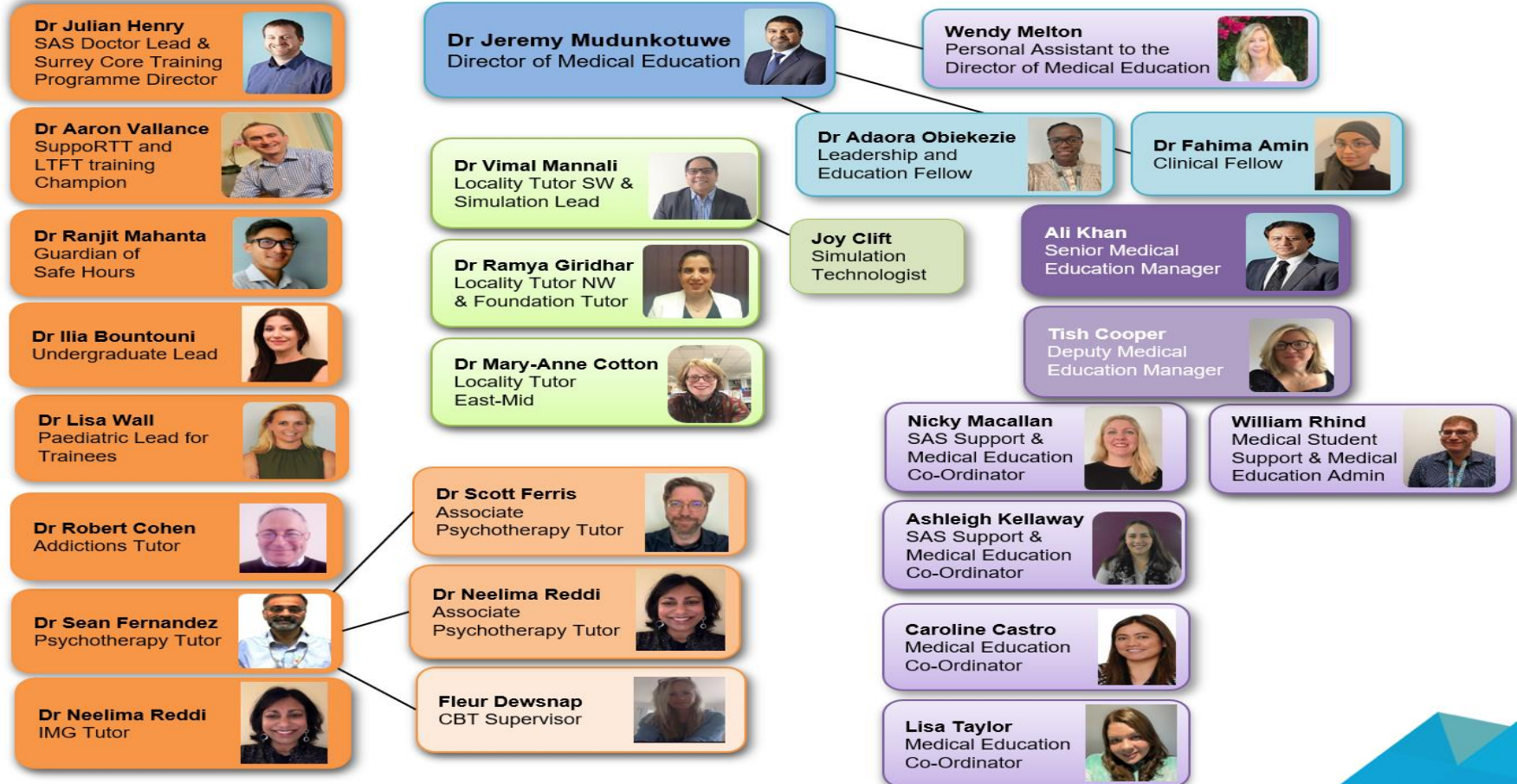

We train >130 Doctors in Training a year

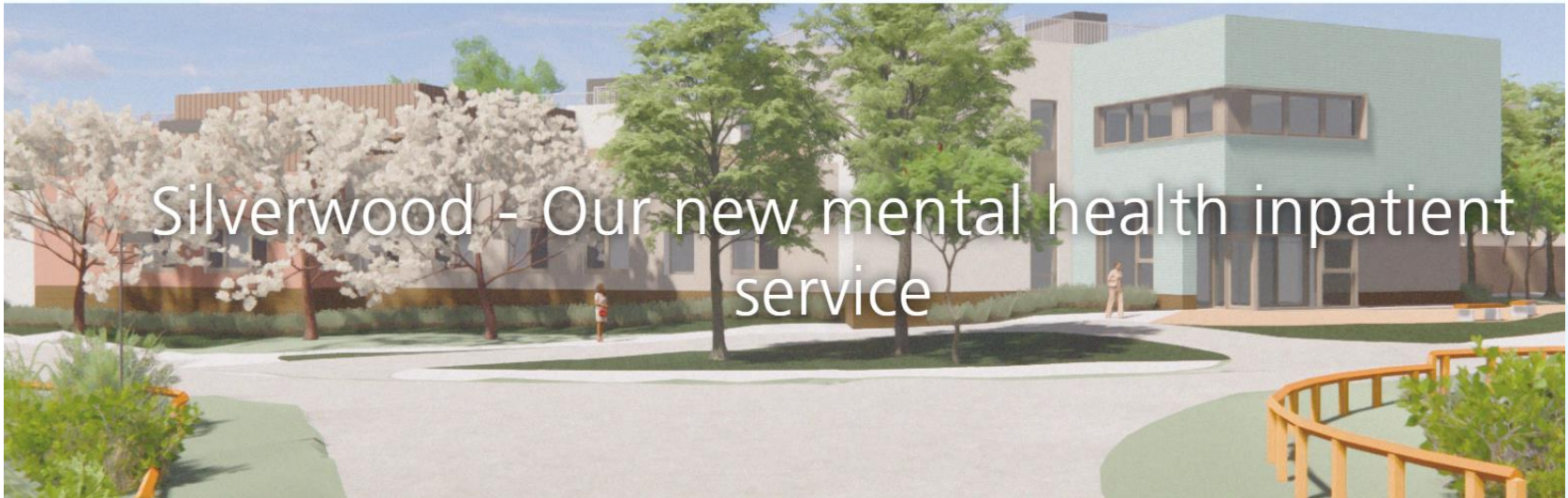
Our FY Posts are situated in 3 main areas
