





Did you know that you can now join us post FY2, as a Trainee Medical Officer and we can take you through your speciality training, as a full-time regular serving member of the RAF.

Once you join us, you will first complete a General Duties Medical Officer (GDMO) year, develop your medical skills with the RAF, build upon your foundation training, complete our Phase 1 Specialist Officer Initial Training Course (SOITC), and apply for speciality training places.

You will then complete your specialty training through to CCT. After CCT, you will use your skills to provide world class healthcare to our patients, wherever that may be.

ROTATIONS

Whilst EM or GP placements are preferable, they are not mandatory. We welcome applications from junior doctors that have not or will not complete these specific rotations.

SALARY

As a Trainee Medical Officer your salary will start from £85,100.
