Eligibility

Working in, or closely with, GP, PCN and other primary care organisations to support GP workforce development. Ideally you would be in an Educator role e.g. Community Education Facilitator, PCN Education lead, GP Clinical or Educational Supervisor

Funding

Education grant support reflective of two sessions a week to develop a project which aligns to placement expansion in primary care.



Commitment

Programme commences 21 January 2026 1 day/2 sessions a week over 12 months. A dedicated project and fellowship mentor Monthly masterclasses delivered in person at York House in Horley
